

SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY USER AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

Little Chute Area School District

363.2-Ex. 1

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By signing this Agreement in the space provided below:

- I (we) acknowledge that we have been notified of the information provided in this document;
 - I (we) request that the District approve the student identified below as an authorized user of District technology resources; and
 - The student agrees that he/she will follow the most current version of the District's "STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY" Rule (363.2-Rule 1)
1. Any student who (1) uses the School District's technology resources, including the District's technology-related equipment, software, networks, network connections, and internet access; or (2) who uses his/her own authorized technology devices at school or in connection with a school activity, is required to follow the District's established rules regarding "STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY." In addition, the District will also enforce other established policies, rules of conduct, or directives in specific situations involving the use of technology to the extent those other policies, rules, etc. would be applicable.
 2. The District's "STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY" Rule (363.2-Rule 1) also identifies and gives notice of many specific conditions under which the District makes its technology resources open to limited and regulated use by students, such as (1) the extent to which the District may monitor, track, and engage in other oversight of a student's activities involving the use of District technology resources (inclusive of student use of the District-provided 3rd party applications such as Google Apps for Education™, MyBigCampus™, etc.); and (2) if a student wishes to use technology (including for communications) in a manner that is secured or private, or that comes with any promise of security or privacy (aside from meeting legal mandates), then he/she should not use the School District's technology resources.
 3. Although additional notice may also be provided by other means, the complete text of the District's "STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY" Rule (363.2-Rule 1) is available via the Internet through the District's web site at: **[insert final URL when known]**
 4. In order to be an authorized user of the School District's technology resources, a student in grades 5 through 12 (inclusive of any student who participates in any LCASD-sponsored course, program, or activity—including summer school) must sign, and, if under 18, have his/her parent or guardian sign, this USER AGREEMENT. The signed document must be returned to the District.
 5. Unless restricted by the District for disciplinary or other legitimate reasons, student users of District technology resources will have access to the internet and will use the internet in connection with various school-related activities, as further described in the District's Policy regarding "ACCEPTABLE, SAFE AND RESPONSIBLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES" (Policy 363.2).
 6. The following are examples of some of the additional rules, regulations, and expectations for student users that are specifically addressed within the District's "STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY" Rule (363.2-Rule 1):

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- a. Rules prohibiting unauthorized access to or unauthorized modification of networks, systems, equipment, accounts, applications, etc., and similar prohibited activities.
- b. Rules and expectations related to copyright law, licensing agreements, and related issues.
- c. Rules and expectations related to academic integrity (for example, prohibiting plagiarism using electronic resources).
- d. Rules and expectations related to the use of district-issued student e-mail accounts.
- e. Rules and expectations related to all forms of electronic communication by students.
- f. Rules granting students limited permission to possess and use personal electronic devices at school ("bring your own device" (BYOD) restrictions).
- g. Information, procedures and expectations for students and parents regarding the reporting of any concerns related to technology, acceptable use, any misuse of technology, or possible violations of acceptable use.

7. Regarding a student's possession or use of any personal electronic devices at school or in connection with any school activity, the student and his/her parents/guardians also agree (via signing below) to all of the following conditions:

- a. Should I be allowed and should I choose to bring in and use my personal electronic device, I will connect it only to the guest wireless network. At no time will I connect it directly to the District's other networks/technology infrastructure.
- b. My equipment is to be used only for a school-authorized purpose, and my possession and use of personal equipment remains subject to school policies, school rules, and any directives or expectations set by school staff.
- c. I will not hold Little Chute Area School District responsible for the safety, security, loss, theft, damage, or misuse of my personal device.
- d. My family and I are responsible for the technical support and maintenance of personally owned devices, including troubleshooting and any repair costs.

8. Violations of this USER AGREEMENT, violations of the District's "STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY" Rule (363.2-Rule 1), or violations of any other District policies, school rules, or directives that occur in connection with the use of technology may result in school-related consequences and discipline, and may also involve other legal consequences.
